



Professor Patrick Maxwell FMedSci

Professor Patrick Maxwell is a clinician scientist who qualified as a medical doctor in 1986 with Distinction (MBBS, London). He subsequently trained as a nephrologist, on the Renal Units at St. Thomas's Hospital, the Hammersmith Hospital, Guy's Hospital and the Churchill Hospital (Oxford). He also completed specialist training in General (Internal) Medicine. He was a University Lecturer and Honorary Consultant in Oxford from 1996-2000 and Reader in Nephrology at Oxford from 2000-2002. He was then Professor of Nephrology at Imperial College (Hammersmith Hospital) from 2002-2008. Since March 2008 he has been Professor of Medicine and Director of the Division of Medicine at UCL.

He has worked on oxygen sensing for about 18 years and has been involved in a number of important discoveries in this field. He is Registrar of the Academy of Medical Sciences and Chair of the Wellcome Trust's Physiology and Pharmacology funding panel.
