Webpage Development:

• Aimed to raise awareness of opportunities for the Student Research Society and the establishment of a Research Notice Board.

Journal Clubs:

• Existing clubs were developed to include senior peers and link topics to teaching activities.

Skills Workshops:

• These workshops focussed on generic research skills.

Themed DCAT:
