

Open Access position statement

The Academy of Medical Sciences' mission is to promote medical science and its translation into benefits for society. The Academy believes unrestricted online access to scientific publications for all - Open Access (OA) - supports this ambition. We therefore will work to build awareness of, and support for, OA amongst our Fellows. We recommend that Fellows maximise the opportunities to make their results freely available and publish peer-reviewed research articles in Open Access journals, where possible.

As research funder, we will require that awardees:

- Ensure that articles should be available immediately upon publication, or within six months of the publication date, through utilising either a Gold or Green route to OA.
- While the Academy will not fund OA fees separately from our research award, where a publication has been funded wholly by the Academy of Medical Sciences, under-spend on an AMS grant may be used to meet the cost of OA fees.
- Where possible, researchers should seek to retain copyright. Adopting a Creative Commons Attribution (CC-BY) license is recommended as it enables re-use of publications via text- and data-mining.
